

# LUK NEWSLETTER

This month we will be choosing a selection of numbers which will be entered into the UK Lotto for a month to test the theory that certain -lucky – numbers have special meanings to an individual. I am sure that many of you already have your own favourite numbers which have special meanings to you, be it birthdays, house numbers, favourite takeaway numbers ( you know 48 –Special Fried Rice) that sort of thing, but do they really have any special significance?

We will be choosing our numbers loosely based on the theory of numerology with a twist.

To do this we will take the full name and birthdate (which may be fictitious)of the editor and apply it to the following.

1. He has 16 letters in his full name.
2. Those 16 letters consist of 6 vowels and 10 consonants.
3. The 16 letters are then given a numerical value using the chart below giving a total of 69.
4. The separate numbers of his birthdate are then added together eg. 08/ 02/1976 to give a total of  $0+8+0+2+1+9+7+6=33$  which is then added together  $3+3=6$ .

So we have now got a selection of numbers to play with:- 16, 6, 10, 69, 6 ( not much use really!)



So this is what we will do:-

We will use all the numbers we can ie 6, 10, 16,  
Then we will add together the 69,  $6+9=15$  so we have 6, 10, 15, 16

Then because we had two 6's we will add them together  $6+6=12$  giving 6, 10, 12, 15, 16, still not enough, so we will add them all together  $6+10+12+15+16=59$  (oops too many, so we'll add them together!)  $5+9=14$  giving us 6, 10, 12, 14, 15, 16 our six number selection!

So there we have it our very own lucky number selection the lukilottery way, how can it fail?

I am sure, like myself, you will be breathless with anticipation come the next Lotto draw. So until then be lucky!
